Details of Offence

Peter Masniuk practised as a barrister and carried out a reserved legal activity, namely the exercise of rights of audience between the 1st May 2015 and the 4th August 2015 when not entitled to do so under the Legal Services Act 2007 because he did not have a valid practising certificate in place. This failure was serious by virtue of its nature and that it may constitute a criminal offence under s14 of the Legal Services Act 2007.

SENTENCE: Fined £500. Reprimanded.

STATUS: Open to Appeal.
