Details of offence:

Richard Keogh engaged in conduct which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in the profession, in that on or about 18 September 2018, he assaulted Person A contrary to section 39 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988 for which he was convicted by the South Essex Magistrates Court on 7 February 2019 and sentenced to a fine of £500.

Richard Keogh engaged in conduct which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in the profession, in that on or about 18 September 2018, he assaulted Person B contrary to section 39 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988 for which he was convicted by the South Essex Magistrates Court on 7 February 2019 and sentenced to a fine of £500.

Richard Keogh engaged in conduct which was likely to diminish the trust and confidence which the public places in the profession, in that on or about 18 September 2018, he assaulted Person C contrary to section 39 of the Criminal Justice Act 1988 for which he was convicted by the South Essex Magistrates Court on 7 February 2019 and sentenced to a fine of £500.

Sanction: 28 Days Suspension.
